



USE of SEATBELTS SOG

SCOPE

This guideline shall apply to all members of the Stoney Point Fire Department (SPFD) and shall be adhered to by all members.

PURPOSE

The purpose of this SOG is to outline the correct use of seatbelts while riding apparatus owned and operated by the SPFD.

DEFINITIONS

SHALL - Indicates a mandatory requirement.

GUIDELINES

Any passenger of a Stoney Point Fire Department vehicle shall wear seat belts whenever the vehicle is in motion.

Since wearing of airpicks in a non airpick seat would preclude use of the seat belt, airpicks must not be worn while these vehicles are in motion.

Vehicles with airpick seats allow the firefighter to wear seat belts; therefore, seat belts must be worn, even if donning an airpick, any time the vehicle is in motion.

There shall be NO EXCEPTIONS to this guideline.
